HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE:

- ✓ **flammables** include paints, dry or wet, petroleum based products, and polishes
- ✓ **corrosives** include acids, bases, batteries, and drain clog remover
- ✓ **toxics** include poisons, pesticides, gardening chemicals, ammonia, and solvents
- ✓ **oxidizers** include pool chemicals, hydrogen peroxide, iodine, and perchlorates
- ✓ **other miscellaneous** include propane, helium, small oxygen tanks, smoke detectors

ELECTRONIC WASTE:

(Can be disposed of during regular business hours)

- ✓ **computers**
- ✓ **switches**
- ✓ **TVs & monitors**

PROPER CONTAINER PLACEMENT

FRONT YARD SERVICES MEANS:

- ✓ place containers within 5 feet of edge of street (*service beyond this distance may be subject to an additional fee*)
- ✓ place containers at the curb, the night before or by 6 am on collection day (*including some holidays*)
- ✓ containers must not block driveways or other public right-of-way

YOUR GUIDE TO PROPER SEPARATION OF **RECYCLING** **REFUSE &** **GREEN** WASTE COLLECTION



REFUSE CONTAINER

Collected weekly.

ACCEPTABLE

- ✓ Household garbage

UNACCEPTABLE

- x hot ashes or coals
- x dirt, sod, rock or concrete
- x construction or demolition debris
- x heavy metal items (such as auto parts)
- x toxic, flammable or other hazardous materials
- x syringes or "sharps" (call for drop off locations)
- x batteries (household rechargeable)
- x fluorescent light bulbs
- x cell phones
- x CD, DVD & VCR players
- x electric equipment & tools
- x mercury switches



GREEN WASTE CONTAINER

One cart provided at no charge. Additional carts for \$7/mo. RZ6 collected weekly, RZ1-5 collected bi-weekly.

ACCEPTABLE

- ✓ grass clippings & leaves
- ✓ tree, weeds & bush prunings
- ✓ scrap wood (nonpainted or nontreated)
- ✓ pallets (broken down)

UNACCEPTABLE

- x palm trees or fronds, bamboo or pampas grass
- x plywood or particle board
- x painted or treated lumber
- x sod or dirt
- x concrete, rock, or asphalt
- x food waste
- x manure & animal waste
- x other household garbage

RECYCLING CONTAINER

One cart provided at no charge. Additional carts available for \$5/mo.
RZ6 collected weekly, RZ1-5 collected bi-weekly.

METAL - ACCEPTABLE

- ✓ aluminum cans
- ✓ tin/steel food & beverage cans
(please rinse, labels okay)

METAL - UNACCEPTABLE

- x aerosol cans
- x pots and pans
- x foil
- x scrap metal
- x paint cans or other household hazardous waste containers

PAPER - ACCEPTABLE

Most clean and dry household paper.

- ✓ newspaper
- ✓ cardboard (bundle larger pieces and place next to container)
- ✓ magazines & phone books
- ✓ computer paper
- ✓ junk mail & catalogs
- ✓ food boxes (cereal, cracker, etc.)
- ✓ envelopes (including plastic window types)
- ✓ milk cartons

PAPER - UNACCEPTABLE

- x plates, cups, paper or cardboard contaminated with food

GLASS - ACCEPTABLE

- ✓ all colors of glass beverage & food containers
(please rinse and remove lids)

GLASS - UNACCEPTABLE

- x ceramics, Pyrex, porcelain, or other dishware
- x mirrors or window glass
- x light bulbs or stemware

PLASTICS - ACCEPTABLE

All plastic rigid containers with recycling symbol:



- ✓ soft drink and water bottles
- ✓ milk & juice jugs
- ✓ yogurt, margarine, & other food containers
- ✓ shampoo, detergent, & other household bottles
(please rinse and remove lids)

PLASTICS - UNACCEPTABLE

- x plastic bags or wrap
- x styrofoam / polystyrene containers and peanuts
- x toys, furniture, flower pots & syringes
- x five gallon buckets
