The new Customer Portal allows you to access your bill, make payments, and more. All customers, even those previously enrolled in paperless billing or automatic payments, must re-enroll in the new portal.

You can create an account or you can make a one-time guest payment. To sign up, you will be asked for your invoice number and your customer number (or account number) found on the paper statement sent to every customer for the billing cycle with our new system.

Your account number has been updated, so be sure to locate the new one as your old account number will not be recognized.


Your first bill in this new system did not show the discount applied for early payment. This discount will appear as an applied credit or "adjustment" in each successive bill.

Do you have a stack of paper documents that need shredding? Stop by the next American Canyon event:

SCHEDULE YOUR BIC TODAY!

Make an appointment for a free Bulky Item Collection (BIC) before all available time slots are taken. They fill up quickly as the year progresses.

Call **707.552.3110** in advance with your itemized list so we can get you scheduled.

American Canyon residents receive one free pickup a year

that can be used for up to 2 cubic yards, the equivalent of (12) 32-gallon bags of trash, **and** one item containing Freon.

USE YOUR DUMP COUPON Your second Dump Coupon should have arrived in the mail in early September. Use it before February 28, 2025 to drop off of up to 1,000 pounds of residential waste at Devlin Road Transfer Station for free.

Valid ID required and the original coupon must be presented. No photocopies will be accepted, and coupons cannot be replaced.

BOPA HOURS

Residents can drop off batteries, oil, paint, antifreeze, and other household waste at the Vallejo Materials Recovery Facility, 8 AM – 3:30 PM Thursday through Saturday. The facility is located at 2021 Broadway.









For a list of accepted items:





compost soiled paper towels, napkins, egg cartons, newspaper, cardboard (even pizza boxes!), and paper plates without plastic coating.





PRO TIP: If a paper product has a shiny surface, it is probably coated in plastic and should go into the trash.

store food scraps in the freezer so they stay out of the elements while waiting for pickup day. Move them to your green bin before you take it to the curb for collection.







PRO TIP: If you put food scraps in a plain brown paper bag for freezing, the whole package can go directly in the bin.

DO put food scraps directly into the green bin. No plastic bags.

PRO TIP: Line your green bin with dry grass clippings or other yard waste or used and uncoated paper products to keep odors in check.

DON'T be confused by compostable plastics. These often don't break down as advertised and should not go in your green carts. Please place these in your landfill (trash) bin.
