HOLIDAY TREE RECYCLING

Recology will collect your tree curbside until Friday, January 17.

1. Remove all decorations, tinsel, and tree stands.
2. Cut your tree into 3-foot sections and stack them next to your green cart. You could also cut the tree to fit inside the cart with the lid closed.
3. Flocked trees, and other discards that cannot be composted or recycled, can be cut in sections and placed in your gray garbage cart. Or you may call for a special pickup; charges may apply.



GIVING BACK

STREET SWEEPING

SCHEDULE

Residential streets are swept every other week on the weekday after your regular collection. Friday customers have their streets cleaned on Monday, Tuesday customers on Wednesday, etc. Commercial streets are swept every week.

Residents should move vehicles off the street and away from the curb by 5 AM on their sweep day to ensure the entire street gets cleaned. The weeks highlighted in yellow are when street sweeping occurs.

Street sweeping weeks are highlighted in yellow.

EXTRA TRASH SOLUTION

Call Recology at **707.678.4026** at least one day in advance, and we will collect extra or oversized trash that does not fit in your gray garbage cart. Use this service for holiday extra trash or for large items that do not fit in your gray cart.

There are extra charges for this service. Call customer service for information and costs.

PUT LEAVES IN THEIR PLACE

Only water should go in the storm drain system. Please refrain from raking leaves into the street. Properly contain leaves for composting and debris for disposal. Homeowners must make sure that commercial gardeners do not rake or blow leaves into the street. For more information call **707.678.4026**.



HELP SAVE A PET

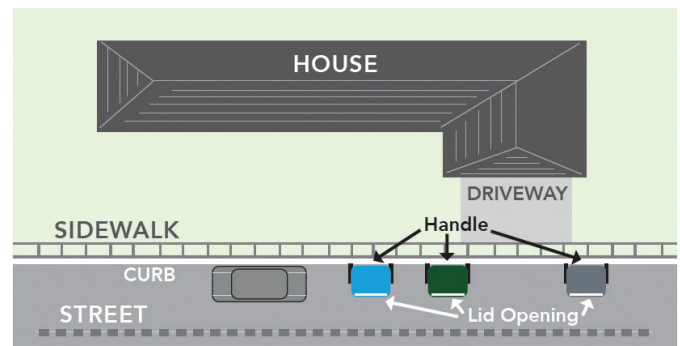
Donate to the Pet Food Pantry and help families in need keep their pets rather than surrender them to shelters.

CHECK FOR PROPER CART PLACEMENT

- Carts should be placed in the street with the wheels touching the curb.
- The lid should open to the street with the handle in the back.
- Don't block the sidewalk.
- Don't park cars within 3 feet of carts.
- Place carts 3 feet apart.
- Put carts out by 6 AM on your pickup day.
- Remove carts from the curb as soon as possible after pickup and place them out of view from the street.
