

HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY

FOR RESIDENTIAL AND MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS ONLY

ACCEPTED

DROP OFF FOR FREE:

ANTIFREEZE: Up to 5 gallons.

COOKING OIL: Up to 10 gallons. Must be in

a screw-top container.

DRAINED USED OIL FILTERS: Up to 10. Filters must be drained. Return filters upside down in original container or container that does not have oil spillage.

USED MOTOR OIL: Up to 20 gallons. Put oil in nothing larger than 5 gallon containers. No glass containers. Do not fill oil to the top of container.

CARDBOARD/PAPER: No limit.

E-WASTE: Anything with a cord. No large appliances (refrigerator, washer, dryer, oven). Up to 5 computer monitors and TVs.

FLUORESCENT BULBS: Up to 15.

HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES: No limit.

LEAD-ACID CAR BATTERIES: Up to 5.

MATTRESS OR BOX SPRING: Up to 5.

PAINT: Up to 10 gallons. Labels need to be on cans. No auto, spray, or craft paints. Empty or dried containers go in trash.

SHARPS: Needles need to be in a sealed biohazard container. (For Vallejo residents only.)
