THEMES

TK-2nd grade: Be the Superhero that Prevents Litter. Draw something that answers these questions: How does a superhero prevent litter? What special powers or tools does your superhero use to keep your school or neighborhood clean and beautiful?

3rd-5th grade: Be the Change that Keeps our Community Litter Free. Think of a place in your community impacted by litter. Draw something that answers these questions: What does it look like? What would it look like if it were cleaned up?

6th–12th grade: Be a Leader in Preventing Litter. Draw something that answers this question: How would you inspire or educate others to keep your community beautiful and litter-free?

RULES

- 1. Students must create original artwork, no existing clip art, computer-generated graphics/characters, or other graphics permitted.
- 2. Messaging: No more than six words per poster. Use bright colors and bold text. Crayons, markers colored pencils, and other art materials are allowed.
- 3. Only one entry per student.
- 4. Artwork must be in landscape format using 8.5 x 11 inch paper. Students must submit both their artwork and a completed entry form as PDFs.
